EVALUATION OF STRUCTURED EXERCISES OF SPEECH THERAPY
5 tables are used for the assessment and promotion of children's structured speech therapy exercises:
In the WHITE TABLE, the child is encouraged by stickers for non-verbal tasks.
In the GREEN TABLE, the child receives stickers by completing tasks for phonemic hearing development and vocal audio analysis and synthesis skills development.
In the YELLOW TABLE, the child clicks on stickers for tasks designed to expand the passive and active vocabulary.
In the BLUE TABLE, the child is appreciated for grammatical skills.
In the RED TABLE, the child is awarded for a sticker, after completing the task of developing a correct language.
The child is awarded with a prize after collecting the agreed number of stickers. By sticking a sticker, the child is happy with his achievements, and after receiving the prize, he feels appreciated for his efforts.
