
The collaboration of teachers, professionals and parents is inseparable from quality and comprehensive education. Parents and educators, professionals should outline common:

- rules that must be applied at home and in the institution.
- General goals, tasks must be specific and minimal to avoid failure immediately.

One of the principles of ABA science is - the rules. Parents, educators, professionals can all agree to work on the course of ABC (more about ABC you'll found in lobe 2.2. Child assessment tools) - in educational activities, at home, in the social life. Extensive information on the behavior of the child at home and in other social situations is very important for teachers, professionals in order to effectively manage behavior.

Parents with educators can adopt a friendly way of communication, promotion and control means. The principles of ABA therapy should be used not only in the educational institution, but must continue at home and apply throughout the life process. Teachers can make individual suggestions in exercises - daily, weekly, monthly - depending on individual needs. In example you can see exercise, used for daily individual information and recommendations for parents.



It is recommended that meetings be organized with parents, and then, as needed, discussions with all teachers, specialists working with the child. It is effective way to involve:

- ABA a therapist/an expert of applied behavior analysis for ABA therapy,
- a psychologist.

Getting ready for new mesmerism and successful inclusion:

- It is recommended to **make photos**: institutions of the environment, spaces, groups, classes. Pictures of people who will work with the child are needed.
- Photos can be made on paper, but you can use a phone or tablet to easily view your photos.

- Using photographs it is recommended to create a social story about the institution (section 3). This is important because new experiences for children with autism cause stress, anxiety.
- Necessary preparation for classmates/group children to know how to behave.
