Aim	<p>The main aim of structured education is to provide for the child a clear, visually presentation of the surrounding environment and the planned structure of the activity.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to create a structured environment; • to form a consistent process of the activities; • to develop the child's ability to perform all tasks; • to make every task complete; • to change the child's behavior; • to develop language and communication skills; • to develop the child's cognitive functions. 																								
Short, detailed description	<p>Child's activity can be planned with pictures or symbols. Symbols were chosen for the development of the speech therapies (R. Ivoškuvienė, Z. Mamonienė, O. Pečiulienė, V. Suveizdienė, "Learning to communicate using the symbols") and a methodical tool "Scheme with Symbols of structured individual speech therapy exercises".</p> <p>79 cards with symbols are made. 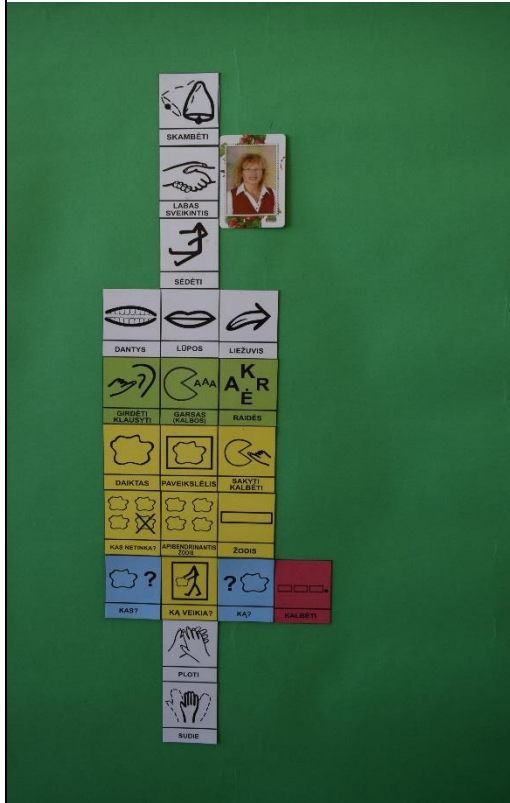
The parts of the speech therapy sessions are based on the level of language development and the child's abilities.
